The selection of Top Children’s Hospitals is based on the results of the 2018 Leapfrog Hospital Survey. Performance across many areas of hospital care is considered in establishing the qualifications for the award, including inpatient care management, medication safety, and infections and injuries. Since moving to its new state-of-the-art facility next to HealthPark Medical Center in 2017, Golisano Children’s Hospital has received multiple national accolades. In addition to being honored by Leapfrog for three consecutive years, the hospital was named as the “Most Beautiful Hospital in the U.S.” by Soliant, a national health care staffing agency, earlier this year.

“Our hospital was built around the health care needs of the children in our community, and it’s an honor to consistently be named among the top children’s hospitals in the nation,” said Armando Llechu, chief administrative officer, Golisano Children’s Services. “Our mission is to keep children as close to their homes as possible, and this endorsement shows that parents can be confident their children are also receiving safe and high-quality care. To earn this prestigious award three years in a row reflects our continued commitment to maintain these high standards.”

This announcement comes on the heels of three Lee Health hospitals receiving “A” grades on Leapfrog’s Fall 2018 Hospital Safety Grades report card last month. Gulf Coast Medical Center, Cape Coral Hospital and Lee Memorial Hospital all received the highest possible grade. HealthPark Medical Center received a “B” grade, missing the top mark by just .03 points.
